Kindly Note:

- 1). To have a proper and meaningful Liturgical celebration, kindly go through some of the important Universal norms on the Liturgical Year and the General Roman Calendar of the Roman Missal given in our Ordo on pages from 2-30.
- 2). For Sundays and Solemnities, three readings are assigned: that is, from a Prophet, an Apostle, and a Gospel. By these the Christian people are brought to know the continuity of the work of salvation according to God's wonderful plan. These readings should be followed strictly. During the Easter Season, according to the tradition of the Church, instead of the reading from the Old Testament, the reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles. For feasts, on the other hand, two readings are assigned. If, however, according to the norms a feast is raised to the rank of a solemnity, a third reading is added, taken from the Common.

For memorials of Saints, unless strictly proper readings are given, the readings assigned for the week day are customarily used. In certain cases, readings are provided that highlight some particular aspect of the spiritual life or activity of the Saint. The use of such readings is not to be insisted upon, unless a pastoral reason suggests it.

In the Lectionary for weekdays, readings are provided for each day of every week throughout the entire year; as a result, these readings are for the most part to be used on the days to which they are assigned, unless there occurs a solemnity,

feast, or memorial that has its own proper New Testament readings, that is to say, readings in which mention is made of the Saint being celebrated.

If, however, the continuous reading during the week is interrupted by the occurrence of some solemnity or feast, or some particular celebration, then the priest, taking into consideration the entire week's scheme of readings, is allowed either to combine parts omitted with other readings or to decide which readings are to be preferred over others. In Masses with special groups, the priest is allowed to choose texts more suited to the particular celebration, provided they are taken from the texts of an approved lectionary.

- 3). **Liturgical Readings are given as per the new Lectionary published by CCBI in 2020.**
- 4). **Those who would like to have the readings proper of the memory of the same for that day, kindly refer to new Lectionary.**
- 5). Because of the importance of the memories given below, the readings proper are given for the 26th January, 04th Feb, 18th Feb, 06th June, 22nd July, 28th July, 29th July, 22nd Aug., 29th Aug, 05th Sept, 15th Sept.
- 6). **In new Roman Missal, St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara (Optional Memory) is given on 3 Jan, and Sts. Timothy & Titus (Memory) is given on 26th Jan. But kindly note as per latest CCBI Liturgy Commission, for Latin Rite, St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara is on 18 Feb and Sts. Timothy and Titus is on 27th Jan.**
- 7). **Ordo 2024 Year Liturgical Readings are from 1st December, 2024 to 30th November, 2025.**

LENT

Lent is a time of preparation for the celebration of Easter. The liturgy prepares the Catechumens for the celebration of the paschal mystery by the various stages of Christian initiation: it also prepares the faithful, who recall their baptism and do penance in preparation for Easter (cf. LY 27).

Lent :

1. The weekdays of Lent from Ash Wednesday to the Saturday before Palm Sunday take precedence over the memorials of saints, which therefore may be celebrated only in the particular form laid down by the liturgical books (IH. 237–239; IM, 355a).
2. Only when some genuine need or pastoral advantage requires it, may an appropriate Mass for various needs and occasions be celebrated (IM. 374).
Votive Masses and daily Masses for the Dead are permitted (IM, 381).
3. The *Alleluia* is always omitted, both in the Liturgy of the Hours and in the celebration of the Eucharist.
4. The *Te Deum* and the *Gloria in excelsis* (*Glory to God in the highest*) are said or sung on solemnities, on feasts and in particular celebrations.
5. In the weekday Office, the Invitatory antiphon, the Hymns for the Office of Readings, for Lauds and for Vespers, and the antiphon at the Mid Day Hour are taken from those prescribed for the liturgical time.
6. **It is not permitted to adorn the altar with flowers, and the organ and other instruments may only be played for the purpose of sustaining singing. An**

exception is made for *Laetare* Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), and for solemnities and feasts (CB, 252).

7. For the celebration of marriages, the parish priest should alert spouses to the need to take account of the particular penitential character of this season (OM. 32).

Ash Wednesday is a day of penance for the whole Church of Roman Rite, to be marked by fasting and abstinence from the eating of meat.

HOLY WEEK

In Holy week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, from his messianic entry into Jerusalem until his blessed Passion and glorious Resurrection. Lent continues until Holy Thursday.

Notes:

General: The rite of the blessing of Palms, the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Maundy Thursday, the Good Friday Liturgical Service and the Easter Vigil may be celebrated in all Churches and public or semi-public Oratories. If they cannot be conducted with enough dignity (servers, singing, participating faithful), it is better to have them only in Parish Churches.

For Palm Sunday:

- a) Red vestments for all ceremonies today
- b) Christ's entry into Jerusalem may be recalled as a Procession, a Solemn Entrance or a Simple Entrance. The Solemn Entrance may be repeated but not the Procession.
- c) No Blessing of Palms without Mass, the celebrant must be the same for both.
- d) At the Procession or Solemn Entrance, the Mass begins with the Opening Prayer of the day.
- e) Lay readers may proclaim the Gospel of the Passion; preferably a Priest should take the part of Christ.

- g) Collection taken is for the Sacred Places in the Holy Land.

THE EASTER SEASON :

The Easter Season begins with celebration of the Easter Vigil on Easter Sunday and concludes 50 days later with Pentecost Sunday, the fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated in joyful exultation as one feast day, or better as one 'Great Sunday' These are above all others the days for the singing of the Alleluia,

Notes for the Season

- a) The Easter Candle is kept near the altar or the lectern, it is lit at all Masses during the Octave and on all Sunday Masses of the Easter Season.
- b) On weekdays, during the Masses of the Season, Votive Masses and daily Masses for the dead are not allowed except for pastoral reasons. But the Mass of the Saint whose Memorial occurs on that day may be said.

Notes for the Easter Vigil

- a) The entire Liturgical Service is celebrated at night
- b) There is no 'service followed by Mass,' but the Liturgy of the Eucharist is part of the entire Vigil

Service, The faithful must clearly be instructed on this point.

- c) The celebration of Mass without the Easter Vigil Service is not allowed.
- d) For the entire Liturgical action, the Sacred Ministers dress in White vestments.
- e) In case of necessity, the Easter Proclamation (*Exsultet*) may be sung by a cantor who is not a deacon, in this case the blessing of the deacon is omitted.
- f) Priests who celebrate or concelebrate at the Vigil Service may celebrate or concelebrate again on Easter Sunday, the faithful may similarly receive Communion again.
